Below is a list of recommended items to be purchased before the start of 8th grade.

For LA (with Ms. Hartnett)

- One notebook or binder (for general notes)
- Highlighter
- Pens and pencils
- A pocket folder for homework organization

- Students should bring one article from a magazine or newspaper about something that they think is "controversial". For Science (with Mrs. Brandt)

- For eighth grade, Science students need a **three ring binder or spiral bound notebook or section of a notebook** that is dedicated to science. Students should have both a place for science notes and worksheets. A pencil or pen (blue or black) should be brought to class each day.

For Social Studies (with Mrs. Carpenter)

- 2 dozen #2 pencils
